- 1. Read Genesis 1:26. Scripture introduces the idea that we are made in the "image of God." In what ways do we bear the image of God?
- 2. When God created human beings, he began to speak to them. God begins to relate to His creation. Is it possible to have a relationship with God today? How does God relate/communicate with us?
- 3. If we consider every human as an image-bearer of God, how should this change how we relate to one another at home, work, and in our community?
- 4. God is speaking of our sexuality when he tells us to "be fruitful and multiply." In this verse, why did God design sexuality? What is the purposes for our sexuality according to culture? How have we as sinful people altered God's design of sexuality?
- 5. God instructs us to "subdue" the Earth. What does it mean for us to subdue the Earth? Do you believe we are upholding that responsibility today? Why or why not?
- 6. How will this message impact your life today?
