## **Scripture Passage:**

Exodus 12

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Read Exodus 12:1-2. The Passover celebration will be a reminder of a new beginning for the people of Israel. Have you ever felt as thought you needed a new beginning, or a fresh start? What causes us to feel that way?
- 2. Do you believe that Egypt deserved this harsh of a judgement from God? Do you believe the Israelites deserved the same judgement? How about you? Discuss.
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 5:6-7. Read Exodus 12:24. As followers of Jesus, is it necessary for us to kill a lamb and celebrate the Jewish Passover today? If someone says, "but Exodus 12:24 says to observe the Passover forever," how would you respond?
- 4. God provided a way for Israel to escape His judgement. What did the Israelites have to do to escape the 10th plague?
- 5. This week someone asks you, "how can I be saved from the judgement of God?" How would you respond?
- 6. God judged the Egyptians and had grace on the Israelites. Why? Does God still show grace on some people while executing His judgement on others? Why?
