Exodus: God's Great Rescue

**Bible Passage:**

Exodus 18

1. Moses was “big” and busy ministering to the people of Israel from sun-up to sun-down. It appears from the text Moses could not even care for his family. Has your job ever hindered you from caring for your family? Share your story.
2. Do you ever feel the need to ‘do it all’ and be “Big” in your career or your position in life? What are some possible reasons you feel this need?
3. Moses’ father-in-law noticed Moses’ leadership struggle, and then he took the very important step to tell Moses. Are there people in your life that are “juggling” too many pins? Could it be your role to confront them? Why is it difficult for us to confront them?
4. Share a situation in which you “dropped a pin.” What was the result?
5. What are some task you are currently doing that you need to hand off to someone else? Who are the people in your life that you need to train to do what you are doing?
6. What steps will you take this week to be a “small leader?”
