- 3. The veil of the temple represents sinful people unable to enter into the presence of God. Do you ever feel unworthy or unable to enter into God's presence? Why is it possible to enter God's presence today?
- 4. What will you do this week to spend time with God? How can you enjoy God's presence all of the time?
