Sermon Passage: Exodus 33

- 1. Exodus 33:3 "...but I will not go up among you." Quotes from the sermon: "What good is the land without the landlord? What good is the promise without the promise giver? What good is the blessing with our the blesser?" Is it possible for us to seek the gifts of God but forget about God? Share examples of how this can happen in your life.
- 2. In Christ, sin can't separate us from our relationship with God, but sin can ruin our fellowship with God. What are some indications that our fellowship with God is not good? What does it look like to have great fellowship with God?
- 3. Exodus 33:6. Upon hearing the word of God, the people repented. Have you ever struggled with the same reoccurring sin in your life? What does it mean to repent? How do we live a life of repentance and faith in Christ?
- 4. The desire for more and more things is idolatry. This idea of acquiring more is a driver in our capitalistic society. How does this desire for more and more demonstrate our lack of trust in God?
