Sermon Passages: Ephesians 5:18-33

Questions:

1. How is the Biblical understanding of submission in marriage different than the cultural understanding of submission?
2. The way you submit to your husband should reflect how you submit to Christ. As your friends watch how you submit to your husband, do they see a picture of how we submit to Christ? Discuss.
3. Following Ephesians 5:22-24, Paul says that a husband should love his wife, not boss or Lord over her. Is a 'man-dominated' marriage what Paul had in mind? Husband, how do you "love and lead" and not "boss and Lord" over your wife?
4. Husbands, what are some practical steps you can take to love your wife sacrificially? What do you need to sacrifice, give up, or die to, in order to love your spouse well?
