

Sermon Series: Who is Jesus?

Was Jesus simply a good man, another prophet, demon possessed, a great teacher, a fairy tale...? Or, is Jesus the one true God, creator, savior, the only way to eternal life...? There are many ways to research the answer to the question, who is Jesus. In this summer sermon series, we give the microphone to Jesus and ask him.

Sermon Passage: John 8:25, 48-58

1. Have you ever heard anyone answer the question, “who is Jesus?” differently than you? How do they answer it? How do you answer it?
2. Read John 8:48-58. Who did Jesus claim to be in this passage? Make a list of Jesus’ claims about himself.
3. Why were Jesus’ words in this passage so disturbing to his audience? Do you find any of his claims extreme? Why or why not?
4. The climatic statement Jesus made is verse 58. “I am.” Referencing the Old Testament, what is significant about Jesus’ 2-word phrase? See Exodus 3:14. Who is Jesus claiming to be?
