Sermon Series: Blueprint: God's Design for the Church

Sermon Passage: Ephesians 1

Getting Started: What is the church? Is it a building? How does a church become a church? What is the church supposed to do? We will be exploring those questions and more as we journey through Paul's letter to the Ephesians.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Read Ephesians 1:1, Act 9:1-9, and Philippians 3:7-11. Who was Paul? When Paul met Jesus, how did his life change?
- 2. Read Acts 19:8-10. What did Paul do to begin the church in Ephesus? How did "all of the residents of Asia" hear the gospel?
- 3. As a follower of Jesus, how can you help spread the message of the gospel? What challenges do you face?
- 4. Read Acts 19:11-17; 18-20; 23-29. How did the church disrupt the culture in Ephesus? Should the church disrupt culture? How?
- 5. Imagine a friend asks you, "Why do you go to church?" Discuss your answer to this question.
