Discussion Questions:

1. 1 Chronicles 16:8-13. Give Thanks in God's Presence.

2. 1 Chronicles 16:14-18. Give Thanks for God's Promises.

Name some of God's promises. Why are these promise important to you?

3. 1 Chronicles 16:19-22. Give Thanks for His Provision.

Reflect of your life. How has God made provision for your life? If not for God, where would you be?

4. 1 Chronicles 16:23-27. Give Thanks as Mission.

How can you share God's salvation this week during Thanksgiving? Be specific.

5. 1 Chronicles 16:28-30; 31-33. Give Thanks as Worship.

Read and re-read this passage. Pause for a moment and "ascribe to the Lord the glory due His name."

6. 1 Chronicles 16:34. Give Thanks to God.

Let your heart of thankfulness give rise to an expression of thanksgiving! Recite this passage to God. "We give thanks to you Lord, for you are good; your steadfast love endures forever!"
