Sermon Series: It's a Messiah

Sermon Title: God Became Flesh

Bible Passage: John 1:1-5; 14

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Read John 1:1-3. Did the "Word" have a beginning? Who was the "Word" with in the beginning? Who is the "Word?"
- 2. In reference to John 1:1-3, why do you think John thought it was important to explain the "Word" in this manner? What makes John's view of Jesus unique to Christianity? Do all people view Jesus as John does?
- 3. Is John's description of Jesus as "life" and "light" significant to you? Why?
- 4. Read John 1:14. During the Christmas season, we celebrate the "Word becoming flesh." Is it difficult to understand God becoming human? How would you describe God becoming "flesh" to an nonbeliever?
- 5. In Jesus, "we have seen His (God's) glory." Based on Jesus' life, how would you describe God?

Prayer:

Name the people in your life that don't profess to believe in Jesus. Pray that God would make Himself known to them, and pray that God continues to give you courage to share the truth of Jesus with them.
