- 4. We are to walk with all "humility." What does it look like to walk humbly at home, at work, in the church, and in the community?
- 5. Paul tells us to "bear with one another in love." When is the last time you struggled to keep loving someone who wasn't loving you in return? How has Christ loved you? So, how do we love others?

Because Christ is humble, gentle, and patient with us, and we have His Spirit empowering us, we can also live this way towards others. What sin(s) is(are) keeping us from walking worthy? Confess sin to God this week, repent, and then walk worthy of your calling.
