Discussion Questions:

1. How do you respond to self-centered people? Are you 'drawn to' or 'repelled by' people who are self-centered?
2. How do the plagues demonstrate God's power over the Egyptian gods? How is God proving Himself supreme in our world today?
3. "God is a jealous God who desires the worship of His people." Apart from God, what are some things we are drawn to worship?
4. How does God demonstrate a unique love for His people, the Israelites, during the plagues? Why does God show love for Israel and judgement for Egypt? Does God demonstrate a unique love for His people?
5. "Things aren't always as they appear right now." Prior to the plagues, who's side would you want to be on; Egypt or Israel? During and after the plagues, how would your position change? Who's side should you be on today; our culture's or God's? Why?
