- 5. Israel failed to follow God's instructions. So do you and I. Our hope is not is our obedience, but in Jesus who did obey. Do you ever place your hope in your obedience? What usually happens when you place your trust in you?
- 6. Our appetites can only be satisfied in Christ. Do you have a hunger for true and abundant life? Do you know Christ?
