## **Discussion Questions**

- 1. The wilderness journey out of Egypt was to teach the Israelites how to walk with God. What does it look like to "walk with God" daily?
- 2. God told Israel that they were His "treasured possession." Now, in the new covenant, the church is God's treasured possession. How should we respond to God's love towards us?
- 3. When Moses told the people God's expectations, they say, "all that God says we will do." Did the people live up to God's standard? Can anyone live up to God's standard? Why or why not?
- 4. God gave Israel the law **after** He had established His relationship with them. How did Israel enter into a relationship with God? Did they do it by following His laws? How do you and I enter into a relationship with God?
- 5. Exodus 19 makes it clear that God is "Holy." How should we respect God's Holiness? How do we live in a correct fear of God?
