

Sermon Series: The Week that Changed the World

Passage: Mark 11:1-11

Discussion Questions:

1. In the sermon, this week leading up to Easter is referred to as “The Week that Changed the World.” As believers in Christ, what is significant about this week? How do we live to demonstrate the significance of this week to others?
2. How did the crowd respond to Jesus’ entry into Jerusalem? Read Mark 11:8-10. How would the crowds respond to Jesus’ leadership a few days later?
3. What message was Jesus sending to the Jerusalem community by riding into town on a donkey?
4. In the gospel accounts, it becomes clear that Jesus taught His followers not to place their hope in the physical temple in Jerusalem. What are some things Jesus did and said to teach this truth to His followers? How is this truth significant for us today?
5. What are some details of the triumphal entry (Jesus’ entry into Jerusalem) that you find significant? Why?
