Bible Passage:

1 Corinthians 15:12-19

Discussion Questions:

1. On Easter, Christians celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. What associations, good or bad, do you have with the idea of “resurrection?”
2. Imagine that you were living during the time of Paul. Imagine that Paul turns to you and says what he writes to the Corinthians in 1 Corinthians 15:3-8. Is Paul’s message believable? How would you respond to Paul? What would you ask him?
3. Why is the resurrection essential to Christianity?
4. According to Paul, what is true if Jesus is still dead? See 1 Corinthians 15:12-19.
5. Do you find it difficult to share your faith concerning Jesus’ resurrection with others? Why or why not?
