Bible Passage: Isaiah 6

Discussion Questions:

- 1. How did the seraphim in Isaiah's vision explain God?
- 2. If someone approaches you this week and asks, "what does it mean for God to be holy?" What would you say?
- 3. How did Isaiah respond to this vision? (verse 5)
- 4. What is a proper response by mankind to seeing God's holiness?
- 5. What had to happen to Isaiah before he was able to hear God's voice and commit to act on God's request? (verses 6-7)
- 6. Is it possible that we are not being sent out because we are letting sin reign in our lives? How do we get in a position spiritually to hear God's voice?
- 7. Why did Isaiah ask God, "how long?" in verse 11?
- 8. Currently, which Isaiah are you? a) verses 4-5, b) verse 8, or c) verse 11? What is your next step in your relationship with God?
