

Sermon: Holy, Holy, Holy

Bible Passage: Isaiah 6

Discussion Questions:

1. How did the seraphim in Isaiah's vision explain God?
2. If someone approaches you this week and asks, "what does it mean for God to be holy?" What would you say?
3. How did Isaiah respond to this vision? (verse 5)
4. What is a proper response by mankind to seeing God's holiness?
5. What had to happen to Isaiah before he was able to hear God's voice and commit to act on God's request? (verses 6-7)
6. Is it possible that we are not being sent out because we are letting sin reign in our lives? How do we get in a position spiritually to hear God's voice?
7. Why did Isaiah ask God, "how long?" in verse 11?
8. Currently, which Isaiah are you? a) verses 4-5, b) verse 8, or c) verse 11? What is your next step in your relationship with God?

Pray that God reveals His holiness to you this week. Pray that we will see God for who He is; holy, holy, holy!
