Discussion Questions:

- 1. 1 Peter 5:13. Who influenced Mark's gospel? Who are you influencing with the message of the gospel?
- 2. Read Mark 1:1-8. How does Mark begin his gospel? How is that different from Matthew and Luke?
- 3. Why does Mark consistently use the conjunction "and" and phrases like "immediately?" Where is Mark trying to get the reader and why?
- 4. "Mark's wants to make sure we know the person of Jesus." Is knowing Jesus intimately different than just knowing about Jesus? Discuss.
- 5. Throughout the gospel, Jesus does miraculous things for people, but then he will ask them not to tell anyone. Why would Jesus ask people not to tell others about him?
- 6. What most excites you about studying Mark's gospel.
- 7. In the sermon, Bro. Ricky mentions some events in Mark's past that we would think may hinder him from writing a gospel. Why do we often let our past hinder our present following of Jesus?
