

Sermon Series: Mark: Jesus | Our Servant King

Bible Passage: Mark 4:30-34

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Mark 4:31. To what did Jesus compare the kingdom of God?
2. Why did Jesus compare the kingdom of God to a “mustard seed?”
3. Read Mark 4:32. What happens when the mustard seed grows?
4. The kingdom of God may have begun small, but what promise does Jesus make about the kingdom’s future?
5. Do you ever feel like the kingdom of God is viewed as insignificant and small? Why is the kingdom of God often ignored?
6. What happens when you only see the “seed” but not the “tree?”
What happens when you can only see the “tree” and not the “seed?”
7. Kory give us 3 applications: 1) gather and go, 2) cultivate the most important and 3) hold and hope. Discuss how these applications help us trust Jesus when we are struggling to “see” the kingdom?
