Use page 1 Applicant Information as a cover sheet. Then create and attach separate pages for Sections I-IV. Label each page with the appropriate title and page number. Use double-spaced, 12-point type. Submit five copies of <u>all materials and letters of support</u> in one envelope.

I. Testimony of Salvation

- A. Describe your personal testimony of Salvation.
- B. Describe your personal spiritual growth and current relationship with Christ. (past scholarship recipients: focus on part B)

II. Call to the Ministry

- A. Describe your call to the ministry.
- B. Describe the area of ministry you feel led to pursue at this time and your plans for fulfilling your educational goals for that area.

III. Church and Community Involvement and Leadership

- A. Describe your commitment to your church/community with examples of volunteer work, civic, and other group activities.
- B. Describe any specific leadership roles in which you have been involved in your church/community.

IV. Letters of Support

Include a **minimum** of **three** (3) letters of support. One should be from a current or recent teacher, professor, or school administrator who would have thorough knowledge of your educational aptitude and one from any church leader other than the Senior Pastor of HBC. The letters should be current and dated **January 1, 2021** or later. Past recipients may ask the same individuals they have used as references on past applications to provide a current letter of support.

V. Academic Standing and Transcript

Have the institution you are now attending, or last attended, send one **official** transcript to the Hardin Baptist Church Scholarship Committee. For example, if you just completed undergraduate work, but have not yet begun graduate school, send the undergraduate transcript. High school transcripts should include ACT/SAT scores, Grade Point Average, and Class Ranking. If your institution provides an official electronic transcript, and you prefer to use that method, the contact is timgreer@murray-ky.net

GUIDELINES FOR HBC RELIGIOUS EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Hardin Baptist Church will be awarding scholarships to Hardin Baptist members or former members who are pursuing higher education in the field of Christian ministry.

The criteria are as follows:

- 1. The student must have been a member of HBC for at least 2 or more years.
- 2. The student must feel led of God to pursue a career in the ministry.
- 3. The student must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 at the current school/institution attending.
- 4. The award shall be used for post-secondary education in college, Bible College, or seminary. The student must use any award monies toward expenses directly related to their education in the field of Christian ministry, such as the cost of tuition, books, course fees, and similar expenses.
- 6. The awardees are expected to provide to the committee a statement of how the monies were used on or before May 1, 2022.
- 7. An applicant who has received a past HBC Scholarship award must provide a summary of how the previous award was expended before a new application will be considered.
- 8. Any scholarship award is for use during one academic year. The student may apply again each school year as long as the student is still pursuing the course of study in Christian ministry and exhibits a desire to continue that course of study.

Selection Process:

The HBC Scholarship Committee will determine scholarship awards. To ensure consistency in scoring, the committee will use a rubric to score applications.

Applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria (see attached rubric):

- Testimony of Salvation
- Call to the Ministry
- Church and Community Involvement and Leadership
- Letters of Support
- Academic Standing and Transcript
- Communication Skills
